



LOCAL LAW #1 OF 2010, MORATORIUM ON WIND POWER GENERATING FACILITIES

The Public Hearing before the Town of Schuyler Town Board was called to order by Supervisor Kenneth M. Dodge at 6:45 PM at the Schuyler Town Office, 2090 State Route 5, Utica, New York. The purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public comment on the proposed Moratorium for Wind Power Generating Facilities.

Planning Board Member David Fusillo stated the Town of Schuyler had a moratorium on Wind Power Generating Facilities which had expired. The Town Board will need to approve another moratorium until the final draft

regarding rules and regulations for these facilities is approved. Motion by Szesny, second by Desrochers to adopt Local Law #1 of 2010 for the Moratorium on Wind Power Generating Facilities as presented; all in favor. At the present time, the Town attorney has to review the final draft of rules and regulations, and once it is approved then the moratorium will be lifted.

Supervisor Kenneth M. Dodge closed the Public Hearing at 6:50 PM.
